

Attention Official Scorekeepers:

In addition to tracking points scored, personal fouls, and team fouls, you **MUST** also track time played.

The rule book is setup to track quarters played, but it is important for the GAA Basketball League Scorekeepers to track ½ Quarters played (every 4 minutes).

At the beginning of each period, make a mark through the left side of the Quarter Played Box corresponding to that quarter for each player in the game.

When the officials call for substitutes (at or near 4:00 minutes in each quarter) make a mark through the right side of the Quarter Played Box each player in that quarter.

Once the player participation rules have been satisfied:

- Every player has played at least four half quarters
- Every player has sat out at least one half quarter

the coach may freely substitute. You should continue to mark as noted below for each player that enters the game in the 4th quarter. You do not need to track time played during Overtime periods.
